## OBJECTIVES OF THE DEGREE PROGRAM

The international track of the bachelor's degree in Economics and Management aims to provide students a better understanding and an overall view of the economy, quantitative methods useful in analyzing economic and management issues, as well as accounting knowledge. The Economics and Management courses will give students the necessary training to be able to: construct and develop a reasoned argument with a critical mind,

- develop writing and speaking skills in French and in English,
- be independent, productive and have the necessary leadership skills,
- acquire good communication skills.

This degree provides students with knowledge tools essential in national, international and multinational companies and institutions.

## STUDENT PROFILES

Mostly with a scientific and/or economic background, the international track is intended for students who are curious and passionate about international issues, who want to obtain a better outlook of the global economy, and who want to understand all aspects of globalization, going beyond the limits of the local national economy. Moreover students should demonstrate their ability to work in groups, have good communication skills, and work responsibly throughout the year in order to succeed and accomplish their goals.

## THE PLUS : AN INTERNATIONAL DIMENSION

The contents of the international and classic tracks of the Economics and Management bachelor's degree are mostly the same, as well as the number of class hours.

The specificity of the international track lies in:

- courses taught either in French or in English (see details below),
- a compulsory international mobility for students, which will take place over the course of their bachelor (which is a 3-year program).

The volume of classes taught in English are increasing progressively: 25% the first year, 30% the second year, and 50 % the third year.

Also, students will be part of multiple group projects throughout the years, improving their teamwork competencies.

## INTERNATIONAL MOBILITY : OUR PARTNERS

It will be required for students to enroll in an international mobility: in other words, students will have to study abroad for a semester or a year during their second or third year or they will have to take an internship overseas. In both cases, mobility can take place within Europe (including our ERASMUS partnerships) or outside Europe. Admin support will be given to students to choose their mobility and to look for the founding they are entitled to. Here some examples of Faculty of Law and Economics current partnerships :
