OBJECTIVES OF THE DEGREE PROGRAM

The international track of the Bachelor degree in Economics and Management aims to provide students a better understanding and an overall view of the economy, quantitative methods useful in analyzing economic and management issues, as well as accounting knowledge. The Economics and Management teaching will give students the necessary training to be able to:

- construct and develop a reasoned argument with a critical mind,
- develop writing and speaking skills in French and in English,
- be independent, productive and have the necessary leadership skills,
- acquire good communication skills.

This degree provides students with essential knowledge and tools applicable to national, international and multinational companies and institutions.

STUDENT PROFILES

Primarily designed for students with a background in science and/or economics, the international track is tailored for those who possess a curiosity and fervor for global matters. It aims to provide a comprehensive understanding of the worldwide economy and delve into the various facets of globalization, transcending the confines of the local national economy. Additionally, students are expected to showcase their proficiency work, effective communication, and collaborative year-long responsibility to achieve their goals and succeed.

THE PLUS: AN INTERNATIONAL DIMENSION

The course content for both the international and classic tracks of the Economics and Management bachelor's degree is largely identical, with a similar number of class hours.

Specificities of the international track lie in:

- courses taught either in French or in English (see details below),
- a compulsory international mobility for students, which will take place over the course of their bachelor (which is a 3-year program).

The volume of classes taught in English are increasing progressively: 25% the first year, 30% the second year, and 50% the third year.

Also, students will be part of multiple group projects throughout the years, improving their teamwork competencies.
